- Welcome and Introductions were made and the adoption of the August 13th minutes were approved as written.
- Case Presentation –
- Volunteer to bring a stroke case study for the next meeting.
- Discussion surrounding the current wording in the Stroke Triage Plan. The wording will be changed to account for the way stroke care is being provided within the region. The Stroke Plan Revision will be completed before the next meeting for the group to review and approve to send through the OMDs and up to the State OEMS for final approval. Discussion surrounding the TEMS Stroke Triage Plan and the wording that states the patient would be taken to a primary stroke receiving center versus the wording the patient would be preferentially transported to a primary stroke receiving center. The group would like to place the wording preferentially transported to a primary stroke receiving center back into the plan and send it back to the Virginia Office of EMS, which is what we actually are doing even though the Stroke Plan states otherwise.
- It is recognized that Bon Secours Harbour View has obtained ASRH stroke accreditation and is now listed as a primary stroke center within the TEMS region.
