 - New Business
 - o Data Review from Trauma VPHIB Database:
 - i. Vital Signs on Trauma Patients in the Region
 - The state PI committee is looking at complete vital signs and where those patients are going based on the Trauma Triage guidelines, the group would like to replicate the states process regionally.
- After much discussion regarding flawed data, Valeria Mitchell recommended asking one of the state PI reps to attend the next meeting to figure out how we can look at our data in real time.
- The group tabled talking

- Short Discussion about the use of tourniquets and Cyanokits. No clear direction on how to proceed forward with the Cyanokits. Unsure if the pre-hospital use of the Cyanokits is the best however no patient that has come into the trauma center that needed the Cyanokit has not received it. Utilization is very infrequent in the region; better off getting them out giving them oxygen and letting the hospital decide to administer.
