Welcome/Introductions were made and the September 2016 minutes were approved.

The group had a roundtable discussion on what it would take to pull specific criteria, perhaps requesting assistance from OEMS. The group thought that it would be interesting to pull data to see how many trauma patients go to non-designated trauma centers, die within the first 24 hours and if those patients should have been transported there in the first place. Moreover, the reporting system that we are currently using doesn't have any triggers that identify to EMS personnel once a patient has been accessed if the patient should be diverted to a hospital or non-designated Trauma Center. The group also spoke about having the agencies be more proactive and proficient to include details in the PPCR. Even creating a dashboard where the agency pull their own data and reporting it on the dashboard verses getting the information from the state. The next meeting the group will come back with some performance indicators that have to be reported and add to the program. Perhaps incorporating an immediate notification to agency PI reps of missing or incomplete patient data.
